## **Feather Fancier Show** **Rules and Regulations**

**1. All entries close Friday, January 27, 2012.**

No entries accepted after this date. Entry fees must accompany entry. Cheques payable to VPPC **Pigeon Entry Fees** will be as follows:

Adults -\$5.00 exhibitor fee  
-\$2.00 per bird.

Juniors-No exhibitor fee (16 years & under)  
-\$1.00 per bird.

**Poultry Display** - There will be no fees.

2. The show site will be open to receive birds at 7:00 A.M. on show day, Sunday, February 12<sup>th</sup>, 2012. All birds must be cooped before 8:30 A.M.
3. Judging of birds to start at 9:00 A.M.
4. The Club will not be responsible for loss, injury, death or disease of any exhibits, but all precautions will be taken to ensure the safety and well being of exhibitors' entries.
5. The Show Committee reserves the right to reject birds suffering from disease or showing evidence of poor health and to remove them from the building.
6. An exhibitor interfering with the judging or attempting to influence the judge will have his/her entry disqualified. This rule will be strictly enforced.
7. No one except bird carriers and show officials will be allowed in the judging area.
8. Once cooped, birds may be handled only by show officials & carriers until judging is completed.



## Rules and Regulations (cont'd)

9. All birds shown must be owned not less than 30 days by exhibitor.
10. Show Committee has the right to double coop if necessary.
11. **Judge's decision will be final.**
13. **Band Numbers** must be stated on entry form.
14. Pigeons must have seamless bands.
15. Substitutes: Only 2 per class and changes must be given to Show Secretary before birds are cooped.
16. Birds are not to be taken from the show area until after awards. Out of town birds (eg. Calgary, Vancouver, Prince George) may be taken out at 4:00 P.M. Any exhibitor taking birds before designated time will forfeit all prizes. Contact Show Chairman for release of birds from out of town.
17. Champion Rare Breed Pigeon will be picked from all Rare Breeds entered.
18. Money will not be refunded for exhibits entered in show and not shown.
19. The Club will not be responsible for prizes pledged and not received.
20. All exhibitors are asked to be present at 4:00 P.M. for presentation of awards.
21. Be aware of the standard abbreviations listed below:
